Welcome to our 96<sup>th</sup> season! To comply with government guidelines, we have had to make changes to our planned programme. As things stand (August 2020), there will have to be an upper limit of **30** members of the audience at each concert. We are asking our performers to give two shorter concerts (each lasting about one hour) instead of one concert of the normal length, so that more people will have the chance to attend. For the second year running, there will be no increase in subscription rates and ticket prices. Unfortunately, we are not able to offer a reduction for shorter concerts, since our costs will remain the same. Other changes:

- Safety – Government and School guidelines in force at the time of each concert will be observed.
- **All seats will have to be booked in advance – this includes members**
- When you book, please give a 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> option (4.30pm or 7.30pm), in case a performance is oversubscribed
- Non-members who wish to attend an individual concert will need to book in advance and pay by means of contactless card at the door
- Booking for each concert will open three weeks prior to the concert

- The raked seating will not be used, but chairs will be put out singly and in pairs, according to the bookings
